

Youth Art Camp Check in Procedure & COVID-19 Precautions

1. Class sizes will be limited to 10 campers.
2. Teachers & Aides will wear masks during Art Camp at all times.
3. We will have no touch forehead infrared thermometers available for each class. Campers will have their temperature taken before they enter the classroom.
4. In the parking lot in front of the art studios there will be check in tables where campers will have their temperature taken, be given some hand sanitizer, and be checked in by classroom Aides.
5. Aides will be handling all of check in so pens will not be passed around. They will initial in the spaces provided on the check in sheet as each child is dropped off and picked up each day. Parents must still bring their kids to the check in area, and verbally check in with the Aide.
6. During breaks, Aides or Teachers will wipe down door handles and hard surfaces in the classroom.
7. Snacks will still be provided during breaks, and be pre-packaged. However, parents are welcome to pack a snack of their own for their child if they so choose.
8. Before campers reenter the classroom after breaks, they will once again be given hand sanitizer.
9. Restroom breaks will be limited to no more than 4 campers at a time.
10. Sinks and soap are available in each classroom so campers can wash their hands throughout the morning.
11. At the end of the daily camp session, hard surfaces and doorknobs will be wiped down and disinfected.
12. Trash cans will receive new bags, and the old bags will be disposed of daily.
13. The Friday exhibits will be held outside the gallery in the front lawn.

These rules are always subject to change depending on new information provided by the CDC.
