

## **Supply list for Paper Painting**

### **Supplies students need to bring to class-**

- 8x10 Gel Plate (Gel Press or Gelli Plate ordered online)
- 4" rubber Brayer
- Liquid Acrylic Paint in bottles. (small inexpensive ones are great for printing)  
Variety is the best. Include white and black and gold if you can.
- Brushes- 1" stiff brush for the gluing process.  
1 large brush 4-6" for painting entire panel or papers.  
1 small brush for sketching in your image. (advice: expensive brushes are not needed for this)
- container for water for cleaning brushes
- papers on which to paint (pages out of old books, maps, music, photos copied on printer, foreign languages, old homework pages, etc) anything goes. Garage sales and thrift stores are good resources.
- useful items - scissors, wet wipes (for cleaning gel plate), paper towels

### **Supplies I will bring for students:**

- 1) a 12" x 12" panel for each student
- 2) gloss gel medium in small jars for each student
- 3) stencils and stamps for all to use
- 4) extra papers to supplement the papers students bring
